Hessen Day

Hessen Day has been hosted by a different Hessian town or city every year since 1961, and it has since become the biggest regional festival in Germany. International pop groups have now been added to the event's agenda, alongside regional displays in mobile exhibition halls. The event attracts over half a million visitors every year – and not only from Hessen.

Museum Embankment Festival

Weilburg Castle Concerts

The concerts held at Weilburg Castle are some of the cultural highlights of the summer. Around 40 concerts are held from June to August in the castle church with its excellent acoustics, and in the Renaissance courtyard and orangery. The patron of this series of concerts has traditionally been the Grand Duke Jean of Luxembourg, the greatgrandson of the last Count of Nassau, in whose castle the concerts are held.

A spectacular open-air theatre event takes place every year in Bad Hersfeld. Visit the dramatic setting of the 1000-year-old collegiate church ruins to watch performances of classical plays, operas and modern musicals. The church was destroyed by the French in 1761, and all that remained was the 103-metre-long walls and a magnificent Roman arch that provides a fantastic setting and wonderful sound quality.
